## **Head Lunge**

A competitive display in which the whale lunges forward with its head raised above the water.

## Tail Slap

Whale slaps water surface with its tail flukes, creating a loud sound that may be heard for miles.

# **PHOTO TIPS**

Whether you're a professional photojournalist or using your cell phone camera, here's how to capture some memorable photos:

- Use a fast shutter speed to keep images clear. Select outdoor/ sports settings on your camera, if available.
- Use a non-zoom lens setting while looking for whales. Once you've spotted a whale, keep it in your viewfinder while zooming in.
- Look for water blowing high into the air! It means a whale has just surfaced.





