

#### WHALE FACTS

Name – The Humpback earned its name from its swimming style in which its "humped" back breaks the surface of the water.

Size – Humpback whales are among the largest animals on earth. Adults average 50 feet in length and weigh up to 100,000 pounds.

**Top whale watching spots on Oahu** – Halona Blowhole Lookout; Mokapu Point on the Marine Corps Base Hawaii; Makapu'u Point Lighthouse; Hanauma Bay; Shark's Cove; Ka'ena Point on the North Shore; Turtle Bay Resort; Lanikai at Wailea Point; and Makua Cave.


